# **NEW! Age Based Programming!**

From ages 7 through 18, youth progress through levels by demonstrating **The First Tee Nine Core Values**, life and golf skills. All participants, regardless of age, ability, or access are welcome in our programming!

- Age 7-9- First Tee Program for ages 7-9 teaches the game of golf in a fun, safe, and empowering environment. At this age group, we are introducing and engaging participants with both golf and life skills.
- Age 10-11- First Tee Program for ages 10-11 supports the exploration of both character and golf skills in active and collaborative ways.
- Age 12-13- First Tee Program for ages 12-13 focuses on the development of both golf and character skills. The lessons and activities in this program empower participants to explore both golf skills and character commitments appropriate for their stage of growth and development.
- Age 14+ First Tee Program for ages 14+ places a greater emphasis on the personal development of participants.

## **Outreach - School Program - Community Program**

"Outreach" consists of our National School Programs, DRIVE, and any other interaction we have with youth that is not considered our Certification Program. This can range from field trips to our facilities, going to schools and working with their students, and community programs where we interact with kids and their parents.

# **School Program**

The School Program brings our curriculum to the school's gym during physical education class. Through safe, fun activities, elementary students are learning the basic skills of the lifelong sport of golf. By teaching elementary students The First Tee Nine Core Values and Nine Healthy Habits, we're putting them on the course to a healthy and active lifestyle.

#### SCHOOL PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- Create a safe introduction to golf for today's students and teachers.
- Ensure that golf education meets the same national standards developed by the Society for Health and Physical Educators (SHAPE).
- Help students build character and confidence through the positive personal and social values associated with the game.
- Engage students in daily lesson activities that lead to development of basic golf motor skills.
- Show students that golf can be a great lifelong recreation and health-enhancing activity.
- Make the positive values of golf a part of the classroom and students' everyday lives.

## Have You Heard About First Tee's Juvenile Diversion Program?

Did you know The First Tee - Shenandoah Valley works with at-risk youth who face criminal charges? For nearly ten years, The First Tee- Shenandoah Valley has been running a very successful Juvenile Diversion program. This unique program is designed to keep children out of the court system who have committed their first offense. Participants in this program are referred to our facilities by juvenile probation officers from the 26th District Juvenile Court Service Unit. During this nine-week program participants receive mentorship and guidance on goal setting, interpersonal skills, conflict resolution and more. In addition, participants in the program are introduced to the game of golf and the 9 Core Values of The First Tee. The goal of this program is to help participants reflect on the choices they have made and supply them with skills they need to make better choices in the future. We are extremely proud of this unique program made possible through a strong partnership with the Juvenile Intake Officers within our 26th District Juvenile Court Service Unit.

# **Did You Know?**

Did you know the First Tee- Shenandoah Valley has completed its third year of a special program for Veterans in 2022? "Fairways for Hero's" is a program that is tailored to serve active duty and retired local military, as well as local Fire Fighters, Police Officers and Emergency Medical Service personnel. 
At First Tee, we understand the importance of competition to a developing golfer and believe the more options given will reward junior golf in the Valley.
